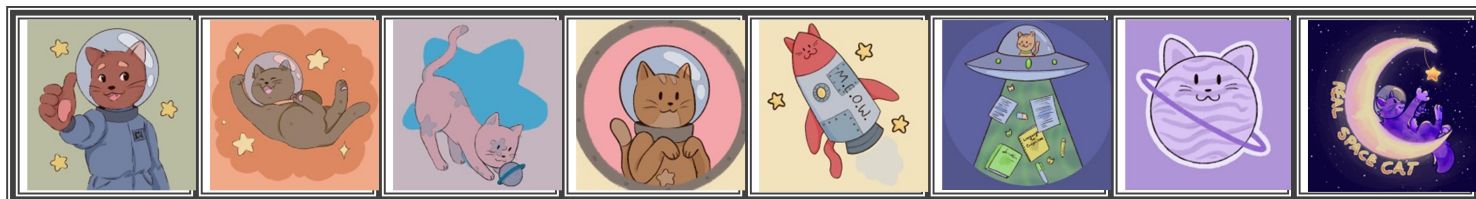






AP ENGLISH LANGUAGE SUMMER ASSIGNMENT 2025

Welcome to AP English Language and Composition, future Space Cats!

This handout describes a simplified version of your summer reading assignment. Please see all posts made in the "Classwork" section of the AP Lang Summer Work Google Classroom for more details and instructions. So that you can plan out your time completing the summer work—which will be substantial—the "TL;DR" version is that over the summer, you will:

 1	Read part of the textbook <i>Everything's an Argument</i> (approx. 100 pages).	Purpose: To introduce you to the core concepts of this course about argumentation: Rhetoric and rhetorical analysis.
 2	Answer questions on the textbook reading (approx. 115 short-answer questions).	Purpose: To encourage close reading and ensure comprehension.
 3	Select, read, and annotate a full-length non-fiction book (length varies; approx. 200 – 400 pages).	Purpose: To engage in critical reading of a complex non-fiction text, representative of the texts we will read in this course throughout the year.
 4	Write a Rhetorical Analysis essay about your chosen text (approx. 3 - 4 pages).	Purpose: To practice what you have learned, writing an analytical essay about how the author communicates their ideas rhetorically in the text.
